# Proposed Legislation Failed (Tabled, Stricken, or Passed-by indefinitely)



- **HB 50** Passing stopped school buses; mailing of summons.
- **HB 243** Passing stopped school buses; mailing of summons.
- **HB 341** Passing stopped school bus; video-monitoring system.
- **HB 915** Passing stopped school buses; mailing of summons.
- **SB 16** Passing stopped school buses; mailing of summons.
- **SB 74** Passing stopped school buses; mailing of summons.
- **HB 93** School calendar; local school boards responsible.
- **HB 571** School calendar; local school boards responsible.
- **HB 753** School calendar; local school boards responsible.
- **HB 788** School calendar; local school boards responsible.
- **SB 340** School calendar; local school boards responsible.
- **HB 967** School term; waiver of length of school term, early course mastery.



# Proposed Legislation Failed (Tabled, Stricken, or Passed-by indefinitely)



- **HB 306** School buses; display of advertising material on sides and rear.
- **HB 73** Driving while texting; fines.
- **SB 730** Driving while texting; involuntary manslaughter, maiming, etc., of another, penalties.
- **SB 778** Use of handheld personal communications devices while driving; penalty.
- **HB 265** Charter schools, public; amount appropriated to local school boards.
- **HB 565** Charter schools, public; changes to provisions for establishment and operation.
- **SB 275** Local school boards; transportation agreements with nonpublic schools.
- **HB 853** Traffic lights; use of photo-monitoring systems.

## Proposed Legislation Failed (Tabled, Stricken, or Passed-by indefinitely)



- **SB 390** Temporary visitor's driver's licenses; DMV may issue.
- **HB 74** Drug offenses, misdemeanor; expungement of records.
- **HB 997** Marijuana; decriminalization of simple marijuana possession.
- **HB 1041** Marijuana offenses; driver's license forfeiture.
- **HB 1074** Marijuana; decriminalization of simple possession.
- **HJ 137** Driver's license; suspension upon conviction of marijuana offense.
- **SB 104** Marijuana; decriminalization of simple possession, reduces penalties for distribution.
- **HB 850** DMV; removes \$5 service charge imposed and collected for in-person transactions.
- **SB 613** Driver's license; marijuana possession.



## Proposed Legislation Failed (Tabled, Stricken, or Passed-by indefinitely)



- **SJ 94 Driver's license; suspension upon conviction of marijuana offense.**
- **HB 850 DMV; removes \$5 service charge imposed and collected for in-person transactions.**
- **SB 540 Early childhood education; all school divisions to provide for certain children.**
- **SB 321 Public schools; kindergarten instructional time.**
